Notice Establishment of restricted areas under a Hokkaido Government ordinance

A Hokkaido Government ordinance restricts access to certain areas of Mt. Apoi to protect threatened animal and plant species. In these areas, walking off the trail is prohibited without prior authorization.

Origin of the name Mt. Apoi

The name Apoi comes from the Ainu term "Ape-o-i-nupuri," where "ape" means fire, "o" means to exist, "i" means a place, and "nupuri" means mountain. The term means "A mountain where a big fire was made."
